



English



In this unit, students will explore a range of fairy tales, to understand how language entertains, and will develop their skills by sequencing and retelling events through speaking, drawing, and writing across a variety of learning experiences. This unit links with Drama.

Assessment: Students will choose a fairy tale to retell and make a personal connection.

Mode: Oral

Maths



In this unit, students will build their understanding of early number concepts by subitising to recognise quantities and partitioning and combining collections up to 10 in different ways, using hands-on activities and real-life contexts to strengthen their confidence and flexibility with numbers.

Assessment: Students will complete short answer questions

Mode: Practical + interview.

Science



In this unit, students explore materials by observing, predicting and investigating their properties, and sorting them based on features such as colour, texture and flexibility. They identify patterns in how materials are used and combined for specific purposes, and create displays to show relationships between materials, their properties and their uses.

Assessment: Students learning will be monitored throughout the term

HASS



In this unit, students explore their family histories and celebrations by sharing stories, comparing the past and present, and learning about the people, events and traditions.

Assessment: Students will be monitored throughout the Semester

HPE



In this unit, students explore how to work in a team, while building fundamental movement skills such as underarm throwing, two-handed catching, and partner balances, and applying these skills to solve a range of movement challenges.

Assessment: Students will demonstrate their knowledge and skills.

Mode: Practical.

Technologies



In this unit, students explore how plants and animals are grown for food, clothing and shelter, and learn how farms help meet people's needs. They investigate healthy food choices, design simple solutions to farm-based problems, and follow steps to prepare a healthy snack through hands-on learning.

Assessment: Students will design solutions for a farm to prepare healthy food.

Mode: Practical

The Arts



In Music, students explore songs, rhymes and chants about different places, from familiar environments to places far away.

Assessment: Students will perform music using different musical expressions.

In Visual Art unit, students will explore how artists use visual language to tell stories, creating their own artworks through drawing, painting and collage

Assessment: Students will create artworks.
