English



In this unit, students explore a class novel by examining themes, character development and ideas. They engage in group discussions to share and develop ideas, use interaction skills to build and support arguments, and compare how ideas are presented through characters and events.

Assessment: To create a podcast episode exploring key events from the novel.

Mode: Multimodal

Maths



In this unit, students order, add and subtract fractions, use all four operations with decimals, and connect decimals to metric measurements. They convert between units of length, mass and capacity, and apply area formulas and angle properties to solve problems.

Assessment: Students demonstrate their knowledge and apply their skills to real life applications.

Mode: Practical + short answer.

Science



In this unit, students investigate how physical conditions affect living things, plan and conduct fair tests, and collect and represent data to identify patterns and make predictions. They also consider environmental impacts and communicate their findings using scientific language.

Assessment: Students will plan and conduct a scientific investigation on the physical conditions that affect the growth or survival of a living thing.

Mode: Practical + Multimodal

HASS



In this unit, students explore what it means to be an Australian citizen and investigate the rights and responsibilities of citizens today. They examine how experiences of democracy and citizenship have changed over time for different groups and analyse sources to understand perspectives, causes and effects, and continuity and change.

Assessment: Students will investigate the rights and responsibilities of Australian citizens today and explore the experience for different groups in the past.

Mode: Multimodal + Short answer

HPE



In this unit, students perform specialised movement skills and sequences, combine movement concepts and strategies to solve challenges, and apply the elements of movement when composing and performing sequences.

Assessment: Students will demonstrate skills of concepts learnt in practical situations.

Mode: Practical.

Visual Arts



In this unit, students explore how artists express social commentary through artworks, and use visual conventions to create a mixed media piece that communicates their own view on an environmental issue, while explaining how ideas are represented in artworks.

Assessment: Students will plan and design artworks to represent and environmental issue.

Mode: Practical

Music



In this Music unit, students develop technical and expressive skills in singing and playing instruments, with a focus on rhythm, pitch and form through music from films.

Assessment: Students will compose and create a music piece to perform.

Mode: Practical

Japanese



In this unit, students expand on previously learnt language while learning to initiate and sustain conversations about familiar topics.

Assessment: Students record themselves initiating and sustaining a conversation with a peer.

Mode: Practical
